RESOLUTION NO. 2016-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA, JACKSON COUNTY, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF MARIANNA, JACKSON COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Property Appraiser has certified the quantity of taxable property within the City for Fiscal Year 2016/2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has delivered his recommended budget for said year, and

WHEREAS, by affirmative motion the City Commission of the City of Marianna adopted a proposed millage rate of 2.8288 and established the tentative millage rate and budget hearing for September 12, 2016, at 5:01 p.m., at the Marianna City Hall, 2898 Green Street, Marianna, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby adopts and imposes a tentative millage rate of 2.8288 for ad valorem taxation within the City of Marianna, Florida for the 2016/2017 fiscal year. This tentative ad valorem tax shall be levied upon the 2016 Tax Assessment Roll for ad valorem tax on all taxable property located within the City of Marianna and is to be used for the City's fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017. The Fiscal Year 2016-2017 operating millage rate is 2.8288 mills, which is the current year roll back rate.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Marianna hereby fixes Thursday, September 21, 2016, at 5:01 p.m. at the Marianna City Hall, 2898 Green Street, Marianna, Florida as the date, time and place of the Final Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Millage Rate Adoption and Budget Adoption Hearing.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA, JACKSON COUNTY, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE ANNUAL GENERAL FUND AND ENTERPRISE FUNDS BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Marianna, Florida, has submitted to the City Commission of the City of Marianna a budget in accordance with State Law; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires that the City Commission of the City of Marianna adopt its annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires the adoption of the City's budget prior to any expenditure of City funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby adopts the tentative General Fund and Enterprise Funds budgets which are attached hereto and by reference made apart hereof, of the City of Marianna, Florida for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016, and ending September 30, 2017, said budgets showing combined sources and uses of \$30,953.198.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Marianna hereby fixes Thursday, September 21, 2016 at 5:01 p.m. at the Marianna City Hall, 2898 Green Street, Marianna, Florida as the date, time and place of the Final Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Millage Rate Adoption and Budget Adoption Hearing.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
